## **South Africa's COVID-19 Occupational Health**

and Safety directives state that employers are obligated to ensure that workplaces are safe for employees to return to work. In line with official directives, employers must not only ensure that surfaces that workers and members of the public come into contact with are routinely cleaned and disinfected, but that hand washing facilities and alcohol-based hand sanitiser must be supplied to ensure health and safety in the workplace.

Hand sanitisers must comply with the National Disaster Management Act (57/2002) COVID-19 Occupational Health and Safety measures in workplaces COVID-19 (C19 OHS), 2020 and (WHO) World Health Organization Guidelines (2009)

The National Disaster Management Act states that a disinfectant or sanitiser product must contain at least 70% alcohol and there must be sufficient hand sanitisers available for all workers entering their facility. With the high demand for alcohol-based disinfectants and hand sanitisers, this has increased the risk of the sale of sub-standard and fake products. They could also cause adverse effects that could be harmful to the health and safety of employees.
